

# Stone Fork Grapple

The Kerfab Stone Fork Grapple, also known as a rock bucket, is a heavy-duty attachment built for clearing, sorting, and handling mixed material. It combines a fork-style base with a hydraulic grapple to grab, sift, and move rocks, scrub, and debris in one pass. It's suited to picking rocks in the paddock, clearing scrub in the yard, and loading logs or debris onto a trailer.
